Terrestrial Biome: A biome on land. Aquatic Biome: A biome surrounding or in water Climate: The average weather conditions in any given area over a long period of time.

Big Picture

1. Biome: Similar climatic conditions on Earth, such as communities of plants
2. Climate: Affected by latitude, longitude, altitude, water bodies. Classified by the average/typical range of variables like temperature and precipitation
3. Rain shadow: Dry area on leeward of mountainous area. Mountains block the rain, which casts a shadow
