Cassava planting commences in April and can go on till October. 60-65 bundles of cassava stem per hectare is recommended as planting material. Each bundle of cassava stem goes for #300. 25cm long cuttings from cassava stem is usually planted using a spacing of 1metre by 1metre (1mx1m).

GROWING CASSAVA

This crop is very prone to the frost condition so try to grow cassava in a frost free area in a warmer region with moderate humid conditions. For growing commercially, a temp. ranging between 23 °C to 33 °C is considered as the ideal one for producing maximum. Also, cassava can also grow well with moderate water availability.

In sub-Saharan Africa (SSA) cassava is mainly a subsistence crop grown for food by small-scale farmers who sell the surplus. It grows well in poor soils with limited labor requirements.
