2. Never miss out on a lesson. Rather than being a hindrance, advocates of the bilingual method argue that the mother tongue of the students is the greatest resource in the language learning process. This is true particularly for those students over the age of 7 or 8, when the mother tongue has been firmly established in the students' minds.

7 Advantages of the Bilingual Method of Teaching English ...

Recent evidence indicates that using comprehension strategies is important for bilingual learners (e.g., Taboada, Bianco, & Bowerman, 2012; Taboada & Rutherford, 2011), and thus intervention teachers were prompted to have students summarize, question, and make inferences throughout guided reading to build comprehension.
