Second Dialect and Second Language in the Composition Class

This course is designed for international and second language masters and doctoral students who need assistance with the composing and writing stages of a course-related project or paper (such as a research paper), a graduate school/department requirement (such as a candidacy exam paper, concept paper) and supporting genres (such as the statement of teaching philosophy and personal statement).
